OK, let's look at (some of) the anatomy of cause-based (here, "fatherhood" promotion) rhetoric setting up public/private/university & paid professional (+ the 501©3s) networking as shown in this example! Key factor from the PRIVATE perspective is to ensure PUBLIC funds are pulled into the mix, justified often by the need to improve, adjust, re-align or otherwise "paradigm-shift" some public institutions. Or in the case of fatherhood promotion, apparently MOST of them.

ON-LINE MARKETING: Website ending \*.gov (houses the Clearinghouse) funded by Social Security Act, Title IV-A (resources), i.e. federally through HHS administered programming.

NFLG is EIN#454542131 and has filed only ONE Form 990EZ in 2014 (revs \$53K), website "N/A" (unpaid) Bd Members Jeffrey Johnson, PhD (interim), Ronald Mincy, PhD (interim, but panel respondent), Carey Casey (Tr) and Bea Haskins \$32K Sec'y. Form 990EZ Tax return (2014=ONLY one found, Assets <\$2K) is a "joke!" NFLG \*\*Auto Revoked by IRS in May 2012\*\* (IRS didn't post until after they were reinstated — with a two-year gap — in June? 2012), after which they twice filed Form 990-N postcards claiming revs < \$50K. Bea Haskins has little web footprint, but does show up at MASBBM (Mid-Atlantic Society for Biofeedback and Behavioral Medicine) with Educ (LinkedIn) Univ. Baltimore (no major shown).
