School districts in San Diego County and across California that use capital appreciation bonds saddle future generations with debt, sometimes at double-digit debt ratios. Vista Del Mar, a kindergarten through third grade school, is one of only two schools in the district whose facilities received an "Exemplary" rating in a recent inspection. Research suggests quality facilities boost student
